Venturi Valves

Venturi Valves

Custom-built for your project = 6–12 weeks(Varies). If you need them yesterday, tough luck.

VAV Boxes

Ready-made and widely available = 2–8 weeks(Varies). Faster, cheaper, easier.

The Verdict: Which One Should You Use?

Go Venturi Valves if,

You're running a lab, hospital, or cleanroom where lives or product quality are at stake.
Precision matters, and you're willing to pay top dollar.

Go VAV Boxes if,

You're designing an office, school, or commercial space where comfort and cost are the priorities. You want something that works and doesn't break the bank.

If Venturi Valves are Formula 1 cars, VAV Boxes are Toyota Camrys. Pick based on what your project actually needs.
